### WASHINGTON STATE APPLES

Since 1920, Washington has led the nation in apple production. Washington grows between 40-50% of the apples used in the U.S. for both fresh and processed use. With rich soil and plenty of sunshine, Washington has the ideal growing conditions.

There are more than 225,000 acres of apple orchards in the eastern foothills of the Cascade Mountains. The orchards are irrigated with plentiful and cool mountain water. Washington state growers successfully harvest a wide variety of apples including Red and Golden Delicious, Granny Smith, Braeburn, Jonagold, Fuji and Gala. There are no harvesting machines for apples and each year, 10 to 12 billion apples are handpicked.

### WINEMAKING

Sweet Pea is produced with only the finest apples that Washington has to offer. After harvesting the apples, they are hand-selected by the winemakers, crushed, pressed and the juice is fermented in steel tanks to develop the crisp, refreshing flavors. A touch of natural peach flavor is added at the end to balance the crisp apple nuances with the sweetness of a peach.

This wine is sunshine in a bottle! Flavors of strawberry apple pie will make you feel like you spent the whole day in a berry patch. Enjoy this wine chilled and now!
