2005 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

TASTING NOTE

A fragrant nose of rose petals and cigar box marries with pipe tobacco and sweet black cherries. Rich layers of dark fruit and black currant are integrated with nuances of oak. The finish leaves wonderful toasted oak and cedar notes woven through lingering fruit. The long finish is supported by balanced acidity and tannins.

VINTAGE NOTE

Columbia Valley's 2005 growing season brought the perfect combination of warm summer months, cool autumn temperatures and a mild winter. With moderate winter temperatures and a prolonged Indian summer the grapes were allowed extra hang time which developed robust Washington wine characteristics. The harvest resulted in high quality grapes with concentrated flavors.
