### nahe, germany

The Nahe region is named after the river that traverses the valleys of the forested Hunruck Hills, as it gently flows toward Bingen on the Rhine. It is a peaceful landscape of vineyards, orchards and meadows intersperse with cliffs and striking geological formations. Although the Nahe is one of the smaller German wine regions, its extraordinary range of soil types is second to none. For this reason, the region is able to produce diverse wines from relatively few grape varieties. Pinot Gris is planted at sites with loam, loess and sandy soils with the result of fuller bodied, very elegant styles.

### vintage note

Good weather conditions in Spring were followed by a moderately warm summer which produced adequate rainfall. September and early October turned into a superb Indian Summer with plenty of sunshine with higher than normal temperatures during the day and lovely cool nights. All this resulted in a high sugar concentration in the grapes with very pleasant acidity levels at the same time. Harvest for began on September 25th and was finished by October 6th.

### tasting note

Fresh, clean aromas give way to a sleek, well-balanced palate of fresh fruit and a soft, supple finish. Enjoy this wine well chilled with seafood or pasta.
