Central Valley, Chile

Vintage Note

The 2007 growing season in Chile was cooler than usual due to the influence of the El Niño weather pattern; however the weather remained dry and stable after the earlier heavy rains and through the rest of the season. Vintners had to wait through an unusually long and slow harvest which promises great quality wines that are expressive in aromas, full color, and concentrated. The cooler but consistently even temperatures and drawn-out harvest allowed for gentle ripening that provided better balance and more elegant wines.

Tasting Note

Wonderful notes of strawberry jam, cherry, tobacco and rose fill the nose. Rose notes continue on the palate coupled with raspberry, clove and cherry. Lingering fruit on the finish is balanced with soft tannins.
