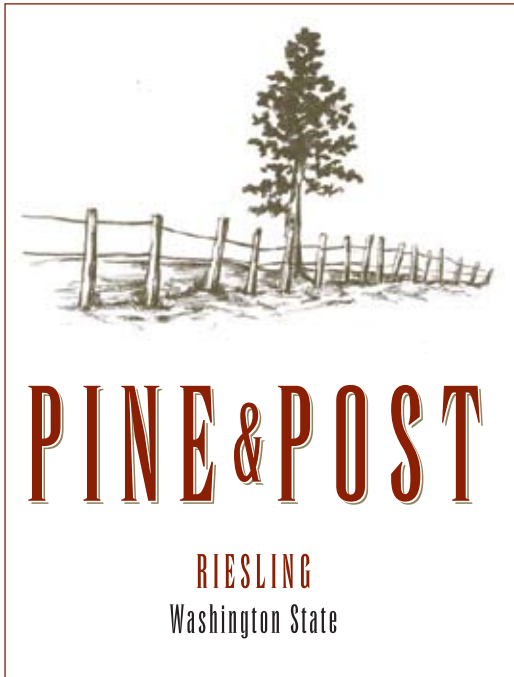


# Riesling

## Washington State



### Washington State

Washington's success with vinifera is due in large measure to the state's unique geography. The vineyards are planted on the east side of the Cascade Mountains, which serve to protect the region from marine weather off the Pacific coast and limit rainfall to just 6 - 8 inches annually. Low rainfall and free-draining soils allow vineyard managers to control vine vigor in order to promote flavor development in the grapes. Warm daytime temperatures ripen fruit to perfection. Cool autumn nights protect the grapes' natural acidity.

### Tasting Note

Aromatic notes of honeysuckle, jasmine and lychee welcome you. This Washington Riesling is filled with wonderful poached pears and apple blossom flavors. Crisp fruit is balanced with bright acidity leading to a clean finish.

### Variety Blend

85% Riesling, 15% Chenin Blanc
