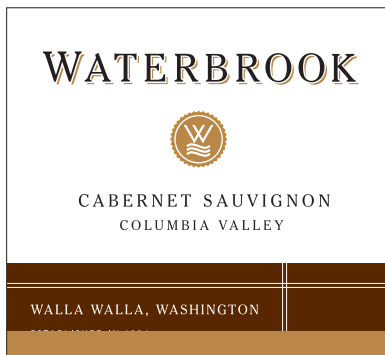

VINEYARD SOURCES

Tantalizing plum, black cherry, currant and leather notes invite you to drink this luscious Cabernet. A mouth-watering palate leads to developed dark fruit notes married with hints of forest floor and cedar. Wonderful lingering fruit is balanced by firm tannins on the finish.

Waterbrook Cabernet Sauvignon comes from carefully selected vineyards in the Columbia Valley. Believing that great wines begin in the vineyard, John chose these vineyards for their overall complexity, richness and balance:

Canyon Ranch, Les Collines, Doval, Hilltop, Oasis

BLEND

75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Merlot, 7% Syrah

VINTAGE NOTE

After a cool spring and moderate summer, the 2008 harvest began in late September, perhaps the most delayed harvest since 1993. Harvest wrapped up in the first part of November. Overall the wines have great fruit flavor definition, medium bodied and complex. The reds, Merlot, Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon, always do well in the state and the 2008 vintage is no exception.
