## Tasting Note

Clean, brilliant pale straw in color this wine offers pungent aromas of mandarin orange, grapefruit, gooseberry and fresh cut grass, whereas wet river stone and/or flint play minor rolls as nuances. Great brightness and direction of flavor, which mirror the aromas to a tee, this wine is a great example of cool climate Sauvignon Blanc. There is richness to the mid-palate, which could only be described as oily, yet the acid is so well balanced that it does not appear sweet or flabby. It sings, dances and convinces you to drink more.
