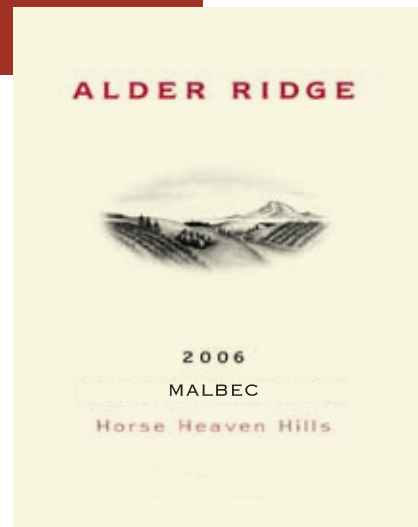

HORSE HEAVEN HILLS

Naturally bounded on the North by the Yakima Valley appellation and on the South by the Columbia River, Horse Heaven Hills was officially designated as an AVA in 2005. It's proximity to the Columbia River and a distinctive topography moderate the extreme temperatures of the area and provide steep, south-facing slopes for quick-draining loamy soils.

TASTING NOTE

A sleeper for the vintage, this wine is just starting to unwind. Super-saturated in color with dark chocolate, ripe cigar tobacco and blackberry cream aromas. The palate is rich, round and persistent displaying silky tannins, bright acidity and a finish that goes the distance; black fruits and vanilla spice along for the ride.
