WINEMAKER – John Freeman

Born in San Francisco and raised in Napa Valley, John Freeman was destined to be in the wine industry. John's initial work in California included seven years at Franciscan Vineyards and an additional five spent as the Cellar Master at Miner Family.

Charmed by the Walla Walla Valley, John decided to move to Washington in 2002. He started at Waterbrook Winery in January 2003 as Assistant Winemaker and was promoted to Winemaker in January 2005.

From vine to bottle, he and his team carefully manage every step of the winemaking process to ensure the overall complexity, balance and consistent quality that Waterbrook wines are best known for.

WATERBROOK VINEYARDS

Believing that great wine begins in the vineyard, John works closely with growers and managers from Waterbrook controlled vineyards and has developed long-time partnerships to select some of Washington's finest grapes for Waterbrook. The ability to blend barrels from several vineyards of different and complimentary styles contributes greatly to the finished wines' overall complexity and balance of Waterbrook wines.

WATERBROOK WINERY

Waterbrook wines are produced on a 75-acre site just west of downtown Walla Walla off Hwy 12. It opened its doors for production in September 2008.
