2009 CARMENERE

Carmenere, a classic Bordeaux varietal was originally planted in France. Today, Chile and South America have the world's largest plantings of Carmenere vines. In the northwest, Carmenere has proven to produce some excellent wines. This 2009 Idaho Carmenere is characterized by its deep crimson / violet color, an aroma bursting with blackberry, plum and raspberry, with accents of toasted vanilla and sweet tobacco. The palate echoes the aroma of dark fruit and light spices giving it a nice lingering finish.
