Red Door Cellars is produced in Oregon, considered to be a cooler climate wine growing region, boasting long, gentle growing season. With warm summers, mild winters and long, often rainy springs, the Oregon climate is particularly well matched to the early ripening Pinot Noir grape.

The grapes in Oregon benefit from growing on a variety of hillside slopes and on a range of soils, created by volcanic activity and sedimentary rock. While Pinot Noir may be the most popular grape grown in Oregon – Pinot Gris has now staked its claim as the leading white varietal.
